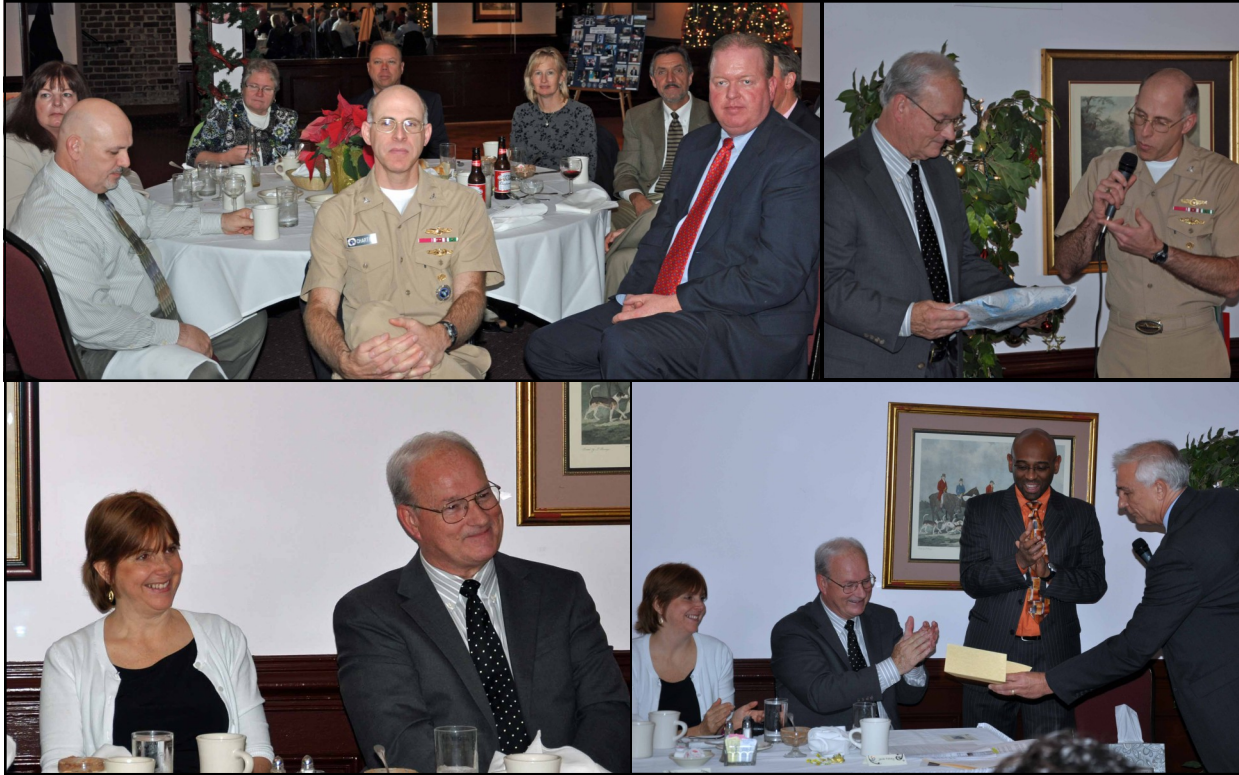
expressed by many. Besides Mr. Greene,
